Primary care

Emergency room

Hospital emergency rooms are for serious situations.

Save the emergency room for:

- Severe pain – especially chest pain
- Sudden worsening of a chronic condition (e.g., asthma, allergies)
- Loss of consciousness
- Poisoning
- Accident affecting the use of body parts or causing severe pain or significant bleeding
- Other serious issues

All emergency rooms are open 24/7. **If you have a life-threatening situation, call 911.**
